Strategic Pillars

The Friends of Chi Upsilon Sigma Foundation fulfils its mission and vision through three core pillars:

1

Scholarships for CUS Sisters: We invest in the academic and professional success of Chi Upsilon Sigma sisters by providing merit-based scholarships that support their educational goals and leadership development.

2

CUS Chapter Grants: Chi Upsilon Sigma chapters are required to host programs that support the development of their local school communities. Chapter awards provide funding that allows chapters to expand the reach and impact of their programs beyond campus, extending into the surrounding neighborhoods where their schools are located.

3

Nonprofit Grants: Funding is awarded to organizations whose missions and values align with those of the Foundation. Through these partnerships, we amplify community-based efforts and support initiatives that promote leadership and positive social impact.

A Year in Review

The year 2025 marked a pivotal milestone for the Friends of Chi Upsilon Sigma Foundation. The Foundation officially launched with new branding, an enhanced website, and a clearly defined mission and vision, solidifying its identity and purpose.

Most notably, the Foundation achieved two of its ambitious inaugural goals: issuing its first nonprofit grant and awarding scholarships to sisters of Chi Upsilon Sigma National Latin Sorority, Inc.

In June 2025, the Foundation awarded a \$2,000 grant to the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Philadelphia during the Chi Upsilon Sigma National Convention. The grant reflected the Foundation's commitment to giving back to the host community and supporting a local nonprofit whose values closely align with those of the Foundation.

Later in the year, the Foundation launched its first-ever competitive, merit-based scholarship program. Three sisters pursuing both undergraduate and graduate studies were each awarded \$1,000 scholarships to support their academic pursuits. The recipients' aspirations include degrees in Health Sciences, earning a Master's degree in Social Work and pursuing a PhD in Sociology.
